

CITY OF NEWPORT 2017 STREET IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT NEIGHBORHOOD MEETING — February 6, 2017 — 5:00 to 7:00 PM

The City of Newport is in the process of preparing plans and specifications for a Street Improvements project in your neighborhood. The City Council has called for a public meeting this evening to discuss the project in general and receive input from adjacent property owners most affected by the improvements.

Project Scope: The primary purpose of this project is to replace the aging utility infrastructure (sanitary sewer and watermains), enhance storm water collection systems and reconstruct the



streets to meet the standard City street section, including concrete curb and gutter.

Other Project Features: Some of the other construction items include:

- > One-way configuration on 11th St. between 7th Ave. & 5th Ave
- New water and sewer services
- Concrete driveway aprons
- Removal of 10th Avenue Trench Drains
- Additional areas for turnarounds (cul-de-sacs)

Design Considerations: The following design considerations may directly affect the adjacent residents and we would like your input. Tell us what we don't know!

- Private property in the Right-of-Way (Planters, Irrigation Systems, invisible fencing, ect.)
- Sanitary Sewer Backups or Obstructions
- Drainage Issues
- Driveway Improvements
- > Tree Trimming/Removal
- Private Utilities
- Special Events & Accommodations
